

Blakebrook Public School

Works notification | 28 January 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to rebuild Blakebrook Public School after it was extensively damaged by floods in 2022.

School building delivery

The modular components of the new school buildings for Blakebrook Public School which were manufactured offsite, are now ready for delivery and installation at the school.

Delivery and installation of the modules will happen in three phases, weather permitting:

- First delivery and installation – Wednesday 5 February 2025
- Second delivery and installation – Wednesday 12 February 2025
- Third delivery and installation – Thursday 13 February 2025.

The modules will be delivered and installed between the hours of 6am and 6pm.

Traffic arrangements

Traffic management protocols will be in place during the three days.

Trucks carrying the modules will be staged at the Quarry on Nimbin Road and will turn left into Rosehill Road to enter the school site.

No heavy vehicles will arrive on site during the morning and afternoon School Zone times. This includes:

- Mornings between 8:00 am-9:30 am
- Afternoons between 2:30 pm and 4:00 pm

Delivery trucks will use the bus zone outside of School Zone times to ensure the modules are delivered and installed as efficiently as possible.

Work hours

We will complete the works as efficiently as possible. The modules will be delivered and installed between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm.
