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PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Intensive Swimming Lessons - weeks 7&8

Healthy Lunch Box ideas





INGREDIENTS

1 tbs oil to grease 2 tsp light olive oil

%cup (firmly packed) grated zucchini, squeeze out extra moisture

- ¾ cup (firmly packed) grated carrot
- ¾ cup (firmly packed) grated sweet potato
- 3 shallots, finely chopped
- 5 eggs, lightly whisked
- ¹/₂ cup coarsely grated reduced-fat tasty cheese
- 2 tbs finely chopped fresh parsley, chives or basil 1 ½ tbs plain flour, sifted

METHOD

- Preheat oven to with oil, then line with non-stick baking pape
- Heat the oil, add the zucchini, carrot, sweet potato
- and cook for 4-5 mins or until the vegetables soften Combine vegetable mixture, egg, cheese, herbs and
- flour in a large bowl and stir
 Spoon vegetable mixture into cake pan. Bake in oven for 20-25 mins. Set aside for 10 mins to cool.

OR use leftover vegies, cut into thin slices and layer in pan, add combined egg, cheese, flour & herb mix.



Mix reduced-fat yoghurt and fresh fruit together. Place into small containers and freeze. Great for lunchboxes.
