PRINCIPAL'S REPORT with Allan Duroux

#### School Swimming Scheme

This program commenced this week and is running for 10 school days for students in years 2, 3 and some year 4 students. I'm pleased to say that despite a cold and rainy start to the week, the children are participating with enthusiasm. They are improving their swimming abilities and rescue knowledge every day. Please ensure you send the required items each day for your child to participate. Tomorrow, Friday 20/11/15, all students MUST take a pair of old, loose fitting pyjamas as part of the "pyjama' safety test. Thank you to Mrs Skorjenko and Miss Sheridan for coordinating this invaluable program.

#### 2016 Kinder Orientation

The Kinder Orientation program commenced this week. Our new students experienced 'BIG' school as they prepare to transition to Blakebrook Public School. The students are having a great time with Mrs Tate and are looking forward to being here all day tomorrow as part of our whole school transition day.

#### Whole School Transition Day

Tomorrow our whole school will transition to another class to gain experience of what may happen in 2016. Next year's classes have not yet been determined and tomorrow's allocation of students to teachers and classrooms is not indicative of 2016 placements.

#### Crunch and Sip

Each morning at 9:15am our school has an early morning tea before classes commence at 9:30am. During this time we encourage children to eat fruit or vegetables and to drink water. We kindly ask that you provide a healthy option for this time.

There has been an influx of non-healthy food making their way into lunch boxes of late. Lollies, lollipops, chocolate, chips and commercial fast food items are not permitted at school. We would appreciate your cooperation in providing your child with a healthy nutritious lunch each day.

#### P&C Meeting

The next general meeting for the P&C will be held next Tuesday, 24<sup>th</sup> November, starting at 5:30pm in the library. The meeting will be discussing the Presentation afternoon and Xmas tree celebrations for the end of the school year. I strongly encourage you to come along to have an input into our school.

#### Bus Zone Parking

Each school morning and afternoon the front of our school becomes a mini-Bus Transit Centre with numerous buses arriving to drop off and collect students from numerous schools. Parents and visitors are reminded <u>not</u> to park in the Bus Zone at the front of the school during the following times: Morning 8:15-8:45am. Afternoon 3:45 - 4:15pm.

#### Year 6 Farewell

This prestigious event will be held on Monday 14 December. Year 6 have decided to go Ten Pin Bowling from 4:30 to 5:30pm then return to school to have pizza for dinner, watch their commemorative DVD and cut their farewell cake. Year 5 and 6 students and parents are invited to attend however bowling has only been booked for the students. Parents are to make their own arrangements if they wish to have a bowl. A separate information note will be sent to 5/6 students in the near future.

#### High School Orientation visits for Year 7 in 2016

The Rivers Secondary College including the three campuses; Richmond River HS, Lismore HS and Kadina HS will hold two orientation days for our year 6 students transitioning to High School in 2016. These dates are Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> November and Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2015. These are full days and families must organise how students will travel to and from the High School on both days. These promise to be action packed days and will provide students with an opportunity to become familiar with the school, staff and general routines.

#### PEER SUPPORT at BLAKEBROOK PS - Week 7 update

In this week's Peer Support session the children will be exploring how to join groups and how to join groups and how to accept others into their friendship group. The activities will give the children a chance to practise these skills, as well as how to say no in a respectful way, cope with being told no and inviting others to join them.

Encourage your child to discuss with you the importance of saying no to people in a respectful way so that they don't lose friends. Also discuss with your child various options they have at school if they should find themselves without anyone to play with during break time.

#### GENERAL NEWS

Year 6 program "Moving into the Teen Years"

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December (Week 9) and Monday 7<sup>th</sup> December (Week 10) all Year 6 students are expected to attend "Moving into the Teen Years". This is a valuable program run by

Intrerrelate, and is being held at Goolmangar PS. Parents are responsible for transporting their children - you may decide to carpool amongst the other Year 6 parents. Students need to be at Goolmangar PS by 9.20am and picked up at 1.00pm. It is expected that students return to Blakebrook for the remainder of both days.

The cost of the four session program is \$32 per student and the deadline for payment and notes is Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> November. This program happens each year for Year 6 students. 
Students will need to take their school bag with lunch, recess, water bottle, swimmers, rash shirt & beach towel. School uniform & hat should be worn.
