Cyber Bullying - Police Talk

On Wednesday students from 4/5/6 listened to a presentation by Senior Constable Presgrove about the consequences and dangers of cyber bullying. It was surprising to staff, to see how many senior students who have social media accounts like Instagram. Senior Constable Presgrove reminded students that the legal age for social media accounts was 13 years old, and that any account set up where a child was not 13 was in fact 'liable', because false information was submitted to set up the account. We encourage parents/carers to always monitor and discuss issues with their children with their personal computer/device time. Students and staff thanked the Police Community Liaison Officer for his time.
