

# **Head lice alert**

Once again these little critters are doing the rounds of our community. Please ensure you check and treat each child if necessary. There are a multitude of products available (shampoos) and remember that a once off treatment isn't enough. Combing the nits (louse eggs) out of the hair with a very fine toothed comb is recommended daily for 14 days. A 2nd treatment shampoo is recommended 7 days after the first treatment. Everyone co-operating & following through is the only way to break the cycle.
