REMINDER - BASC Survey

Have Your Say survey for the Before and After School Care (BASC) program.

After a long wait there is an opportunity for Blakebrook Public School to have an After School Care program run at our school. We need as many parents as possible to complete the survey below indicating they would use the program even if it is only once per week. The higher the demand for the service, the more likely we will have a program commence.

This survey provides important information about Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) demand across NSW. We use these insights to help design solutions that can best meet the needs of families and we are currently exploring ways to achieve this in schools like yours where no onsite service is available.

In order to better understand the care needs in our school community and the impact of COVID-19 on the demand for places in 2021, we have a short 5 question follow-up survey for parents which will provide us with the data we need to inform and prioritise solutions.

Parents who are deemed to need care based on these questions will be offered the opportunity to complete a 10 question demand survey to fast track the paperwork required to establish OSHC at our school.




Heads up regarding a Santa Gift
