#### Vaccinations for staff and visitors and QR check-in

From 8 November all NSW public school staff on-site are required to be fully vaccinated. Any contractors, volunteers or people on site who require a Working with Children Check (including parent helpers and canteen helpers) are also required to have 2 doses of vaccination, from 8 November, before returning to our school.

On arrival to school you must QR code check-in via Service NSW app **School Check-in** (not the regular Check-in, scroll to bottom of list) and show double vaccination status to office staff.


